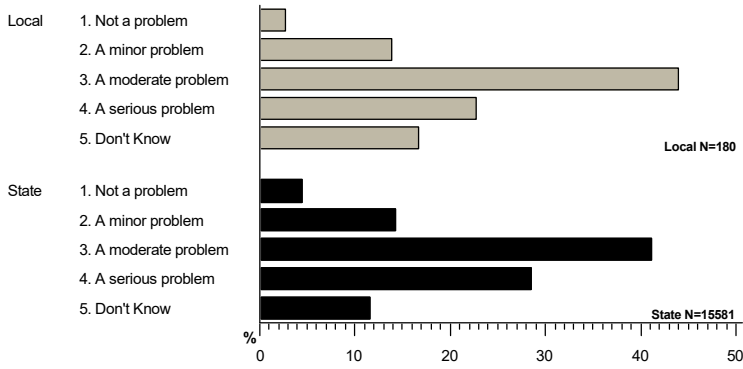


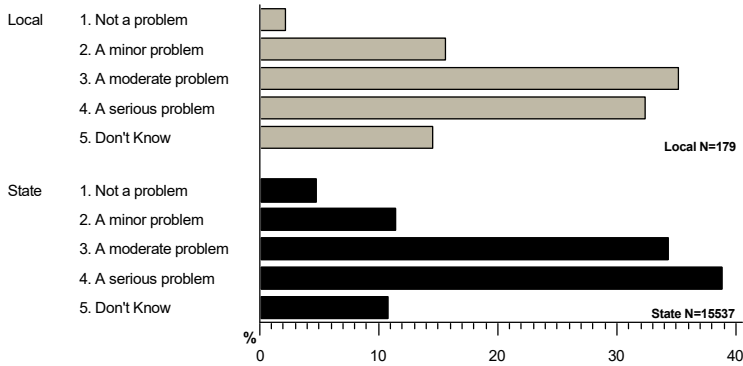

01a. How much of a problem do you think each of the following is among youth (6 – 12th grade) in your community? Alcohol use



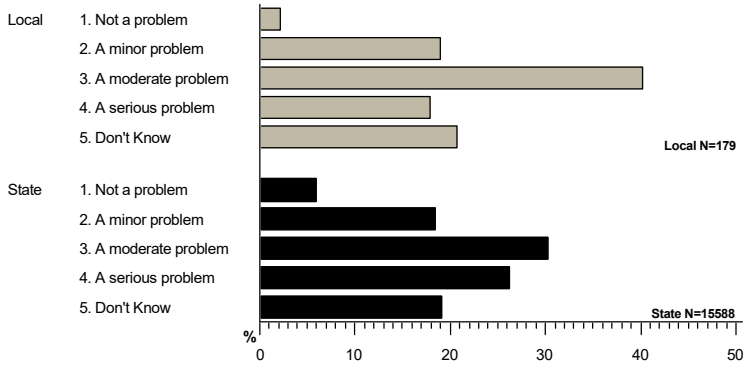

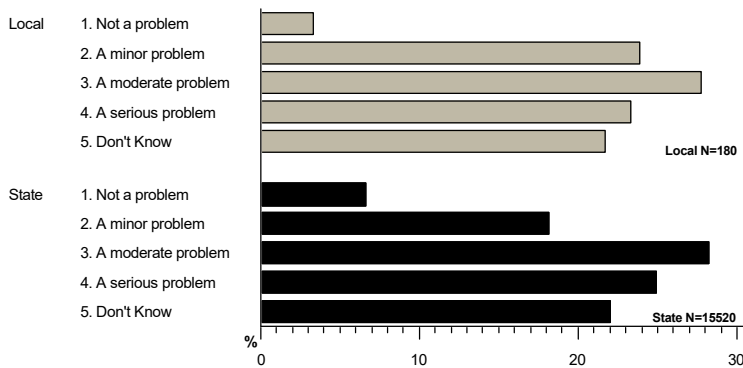

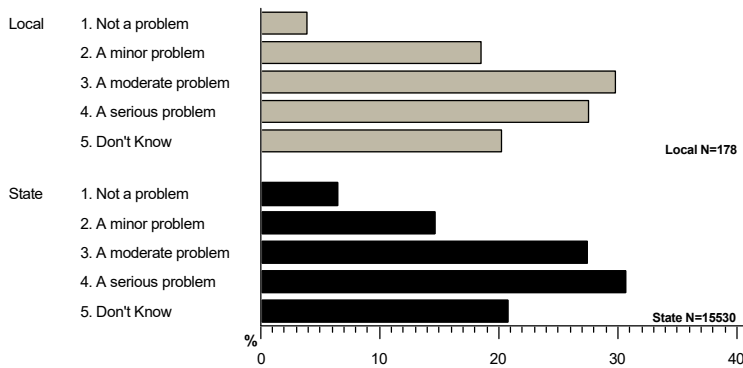

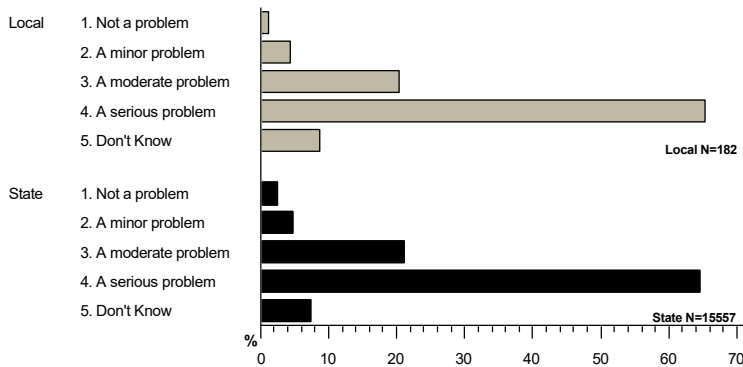

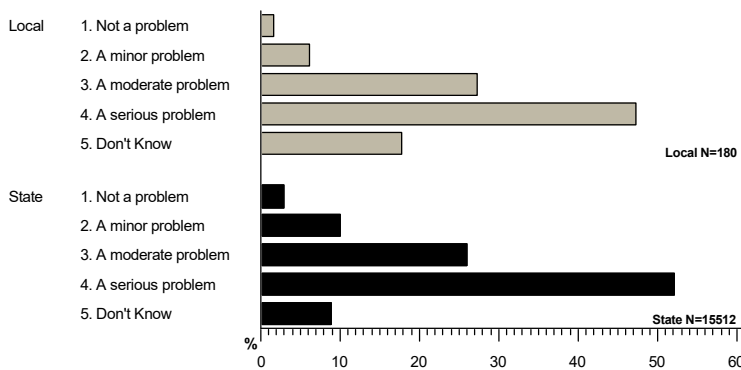

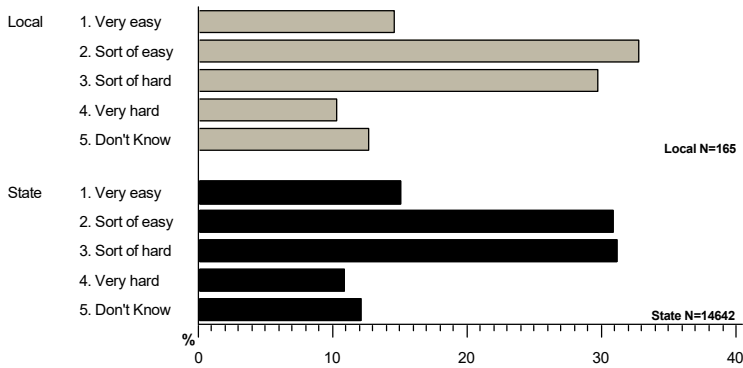

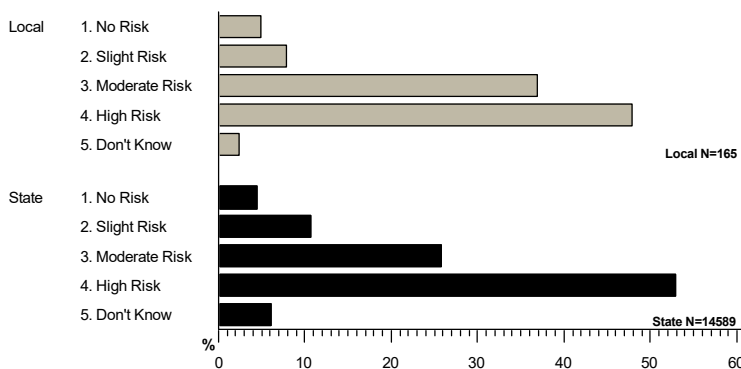

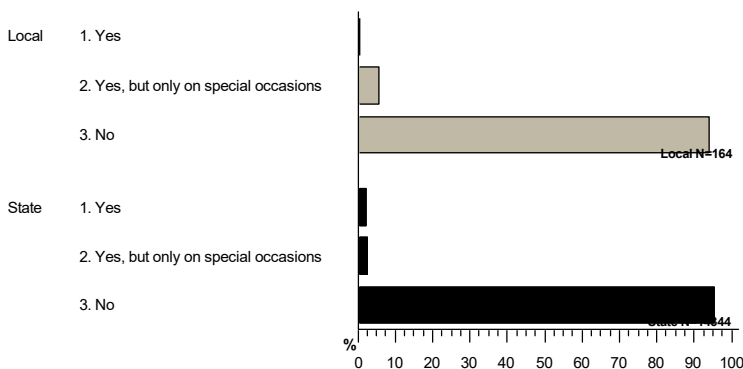

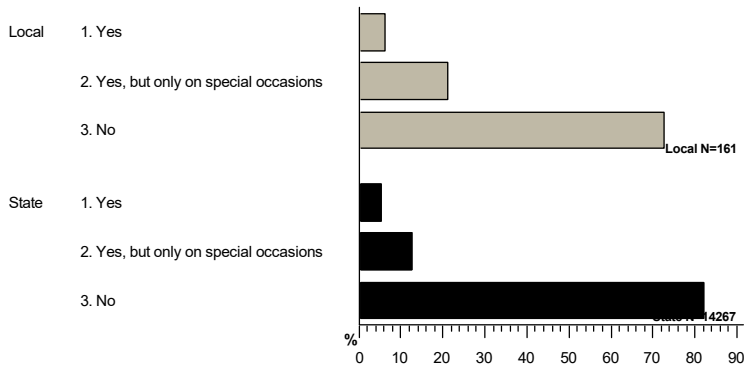

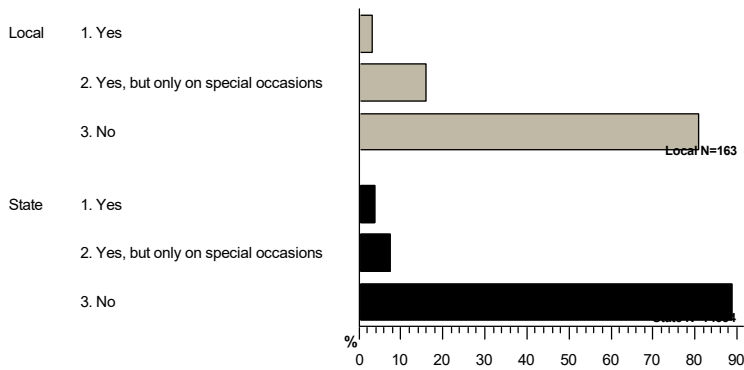

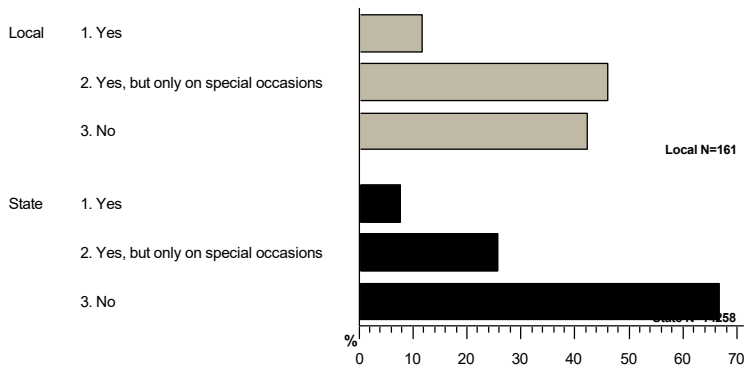

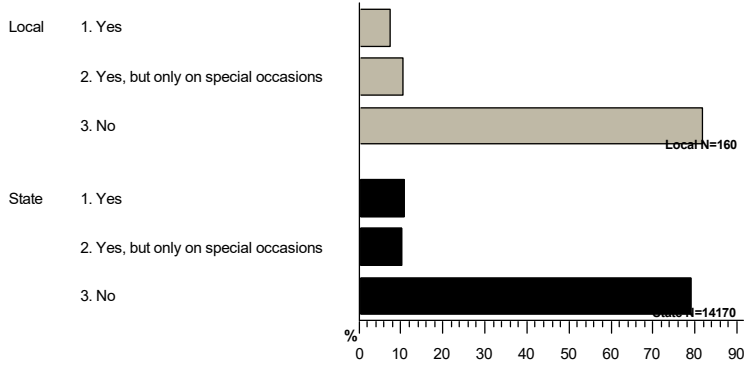

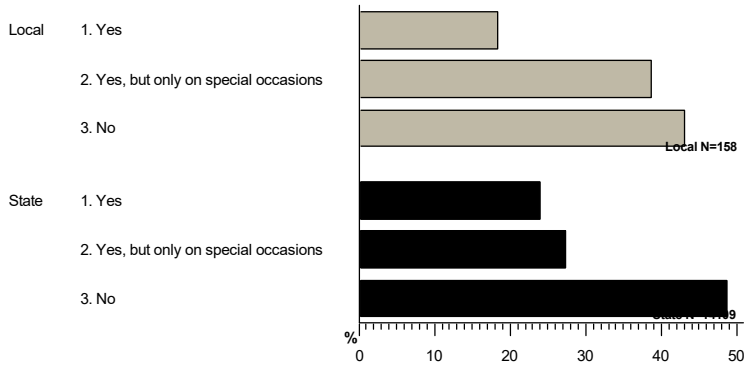

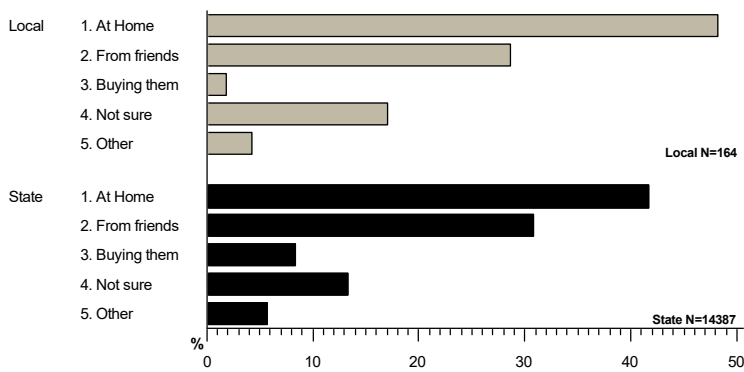

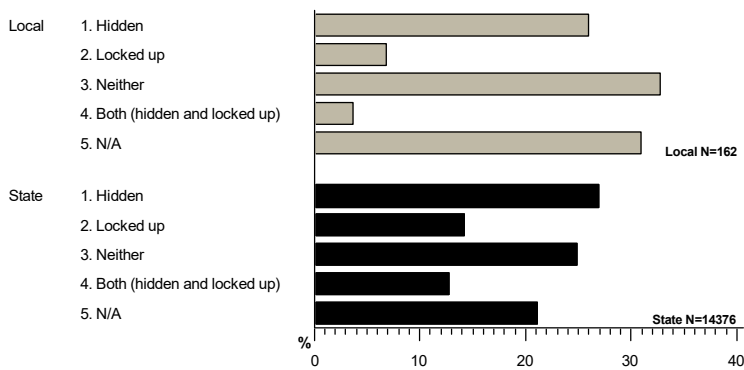

6. Where do you think youth usually get prescription drugs not prescribed to them by a doctor?



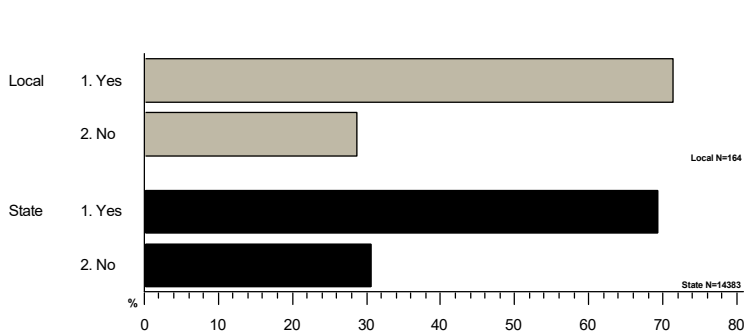

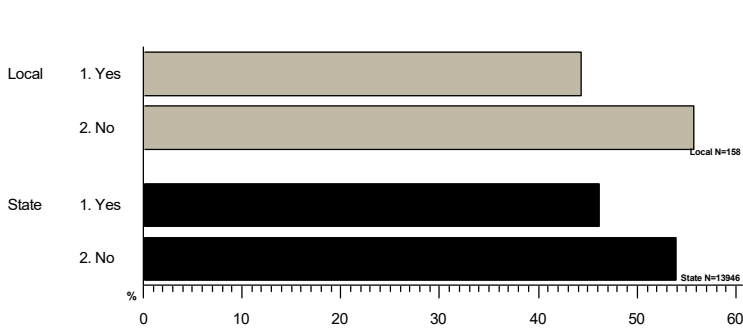

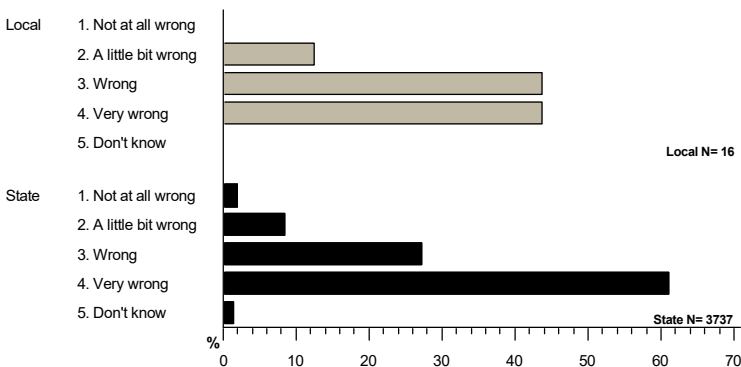

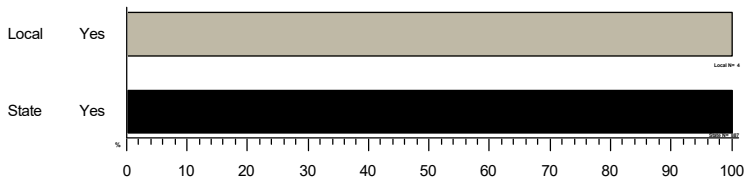
18b. What is your race? Black or African American

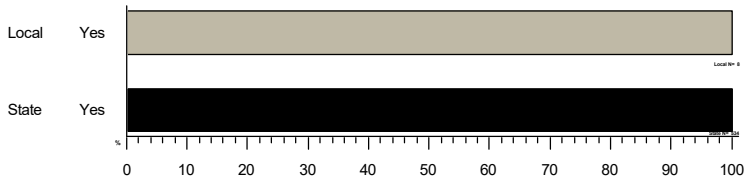
18c. What is your race? American Indian, Alaska Native

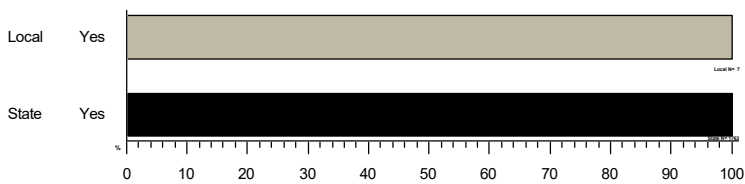
19b. What languages are spoken in your home? Cambodian
