Current Threat Summary				
<p>As of 1/4/20 at 3:57 p.m, there are 233 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Jefferson County. There are now 15,792 total tested, with 15,507 negative results, and 52 pending – 1.48% positive rate for results received thus far. There are 194 Recovered patients. DOH: people are considered recovered at 28 days from the onset of symptoms if they are alive and not hospitalized.</p> <p>Two Week COVID-19 case rate per 100,000: 12/13 – 12/26 – 87.77</p>

<p>Thirteen new cases since last Thursday brings us to 233 total cases. Our 2-week avg cases per 100,000 is slightly up to 87 from 62.7. Busy weekend with tracing and following-up to get people quarantined. There are 2 cases hospitalized at JHC, 1 expected to discharge today, other is improving. Most recent cases: several from out-of-state or out-of-county visitors, a couple were in-county with unknown origin and a few tested positive after being quarantined for prior contact. Will follow-up with EJFR to investigate why a caller with possible non-critical symptoms was asked to call 911 for ambulance transport.</p>

Routine, nothing new. Business: helping to collect data needed for vaccination prioritization.

<p>US now 20.65M+ cases, 1.5M cases in one week. Rolling 7-day avg. 212,965 cases/day – down 1% over 2 weeks. 188,720 hospitalized - up 11% over 2 weeks. There are 31 states with high case counts staying high, including WA and OR and 18 with high and lowering, including ID. HI is only low and staying low.</p>				
<p>WA has 258,557 cases, with rolling 7-day avg 2500/day – flat over 2 weeks. 1061 hospitalized with 11% on ventilators, and ICU occupancy hovering around 75-80%. R⁰ 0.96, up from 0.86 last week.</p>				
<p>JHC bed occupancy avg 37% and ICU avg at 33%, today's actual numbers are 68% beds and 83.3% ICU. Two COVID patients hospitalized after 30 days without any. PPE status is green and no significant staff shortages.</p>				
<p>All adjacent counties have increased cases, Mason county has significant increase. St. Michael's has 15 cases all in the ICU. Their bed occupancy avg is 81% and ICU at 83.3%.</p>				
<p>No new news about vaccine availability for those younger than 16.</p>				
<p>The UK variant, now known as B.1.1.7, is more transmissible (R⁰ of 1.5 vs Covid 19 R⁰1.1) but does not cause more severe symptoms.</p>				
<p>Economy: Covid Relief Bill signed last week, timing of dollars arriving is TBD. JeffCo unemployment of 7.4% is higher than state at 6.7%. Week of 12/20-26 saw 65 new unemployment claims and 6.7% increase in continuing claims</p>

<p>Expect updated vaccine phasing guidelines from state to be updated by Tuesday.
