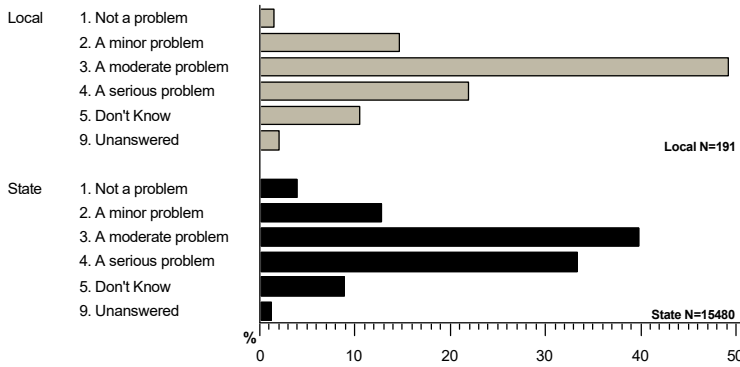


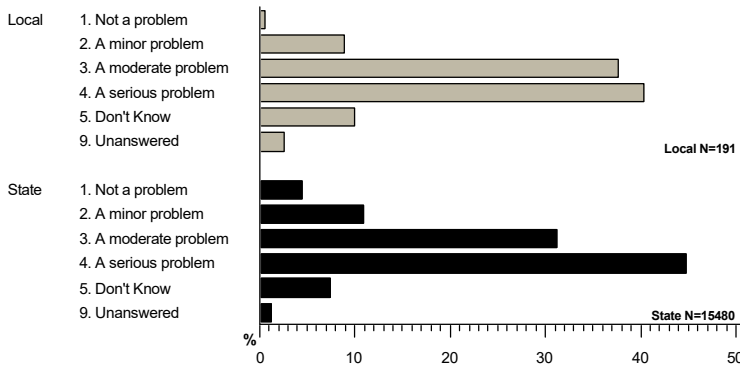

**1a. How much of a problem do you think each of the following is among youth (6th – 12th grade) in your community? Alcohol use**



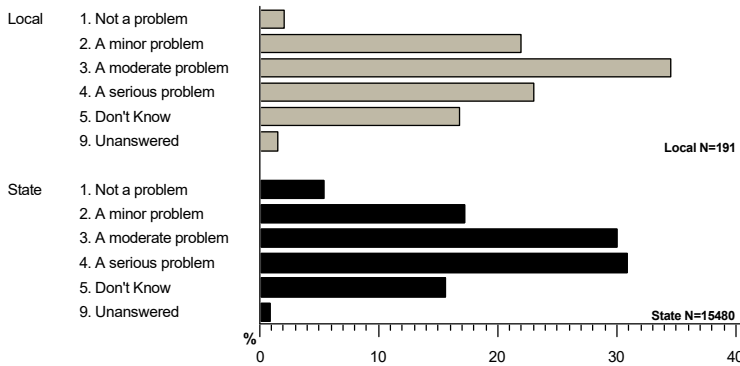

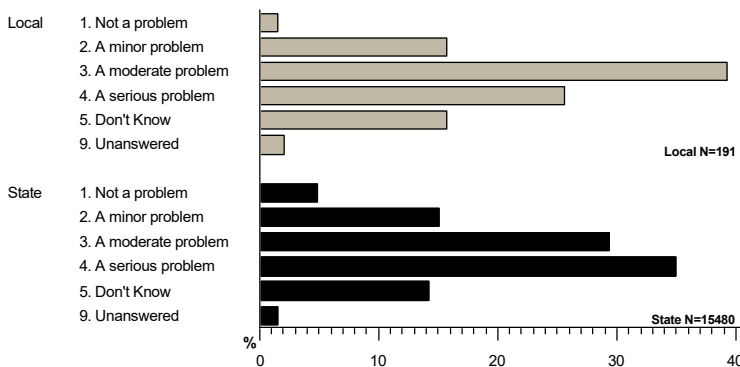

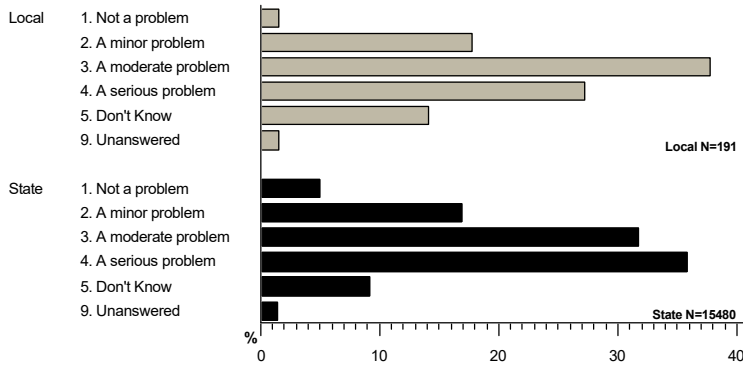

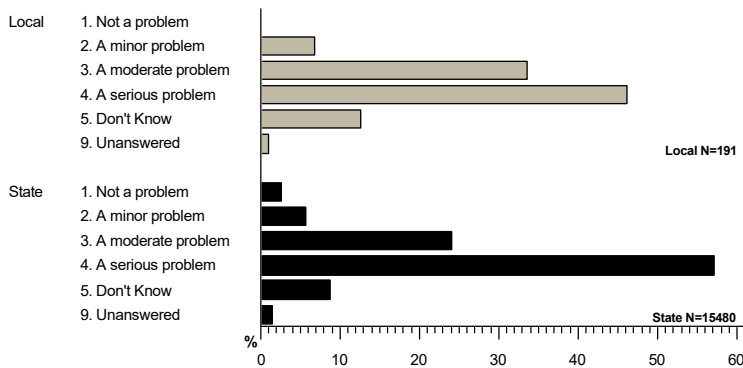

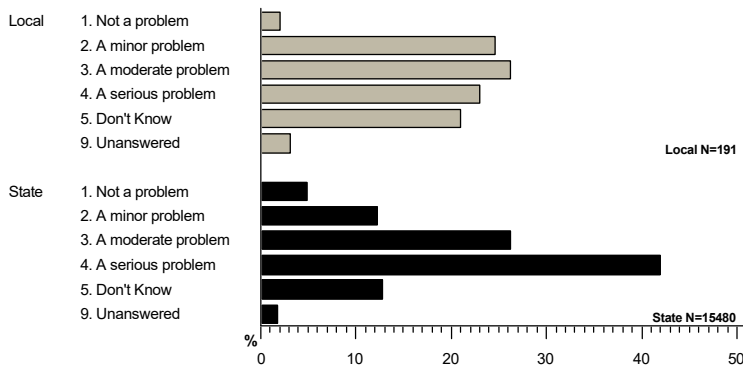

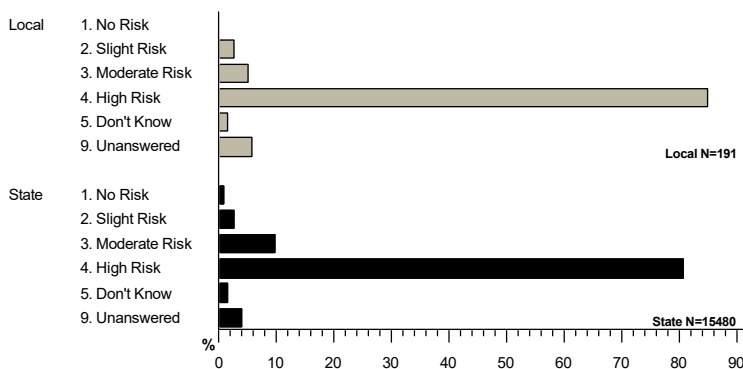

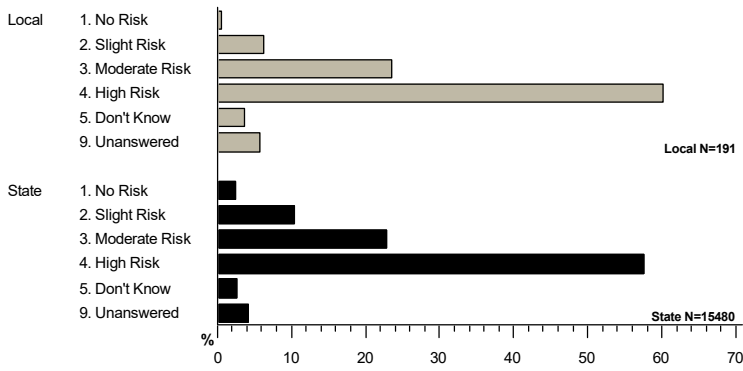

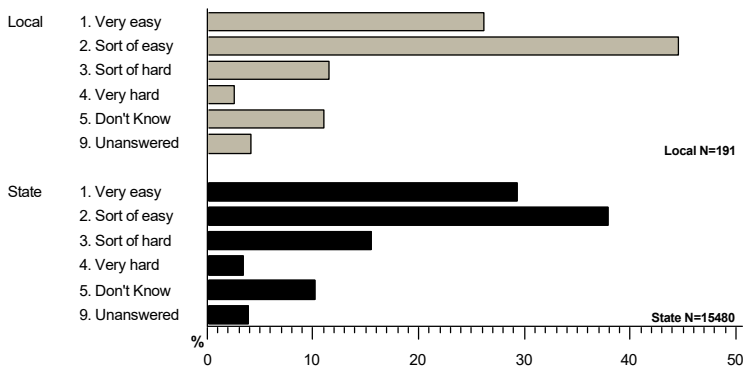

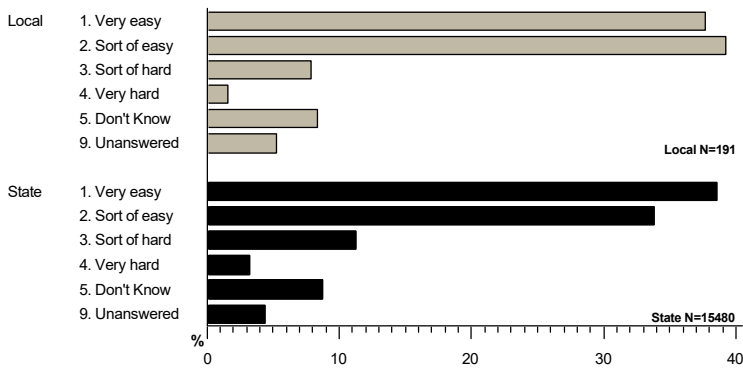

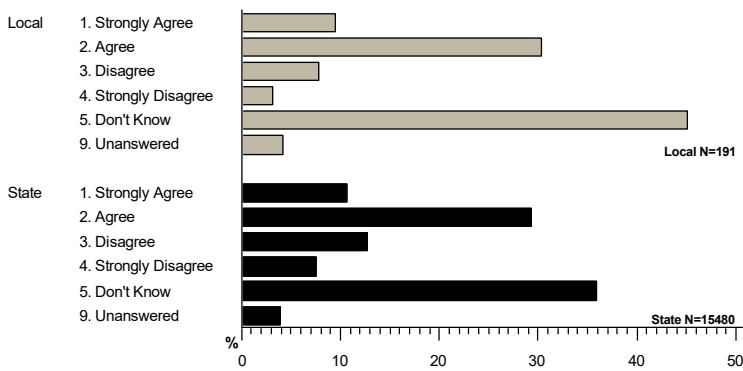

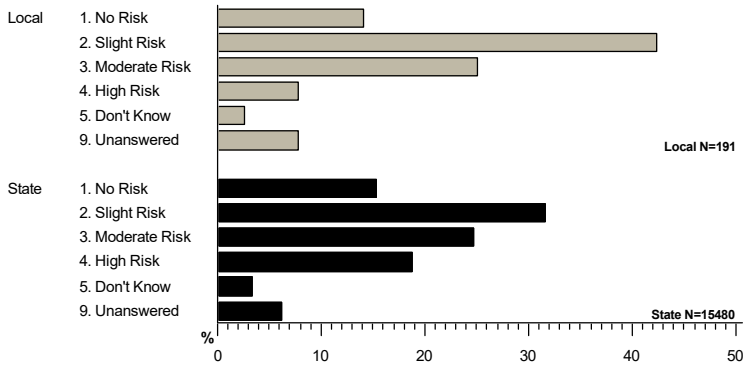

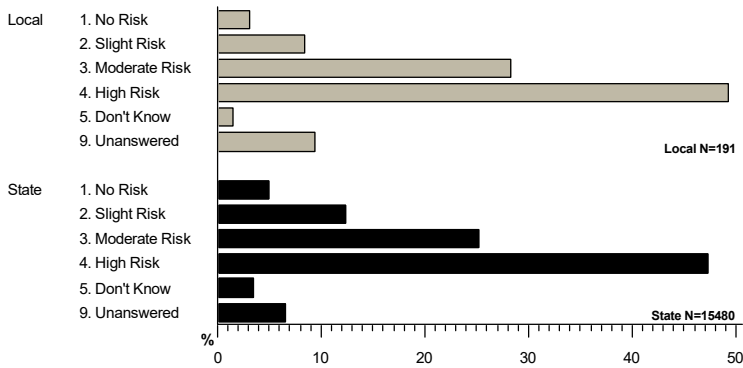

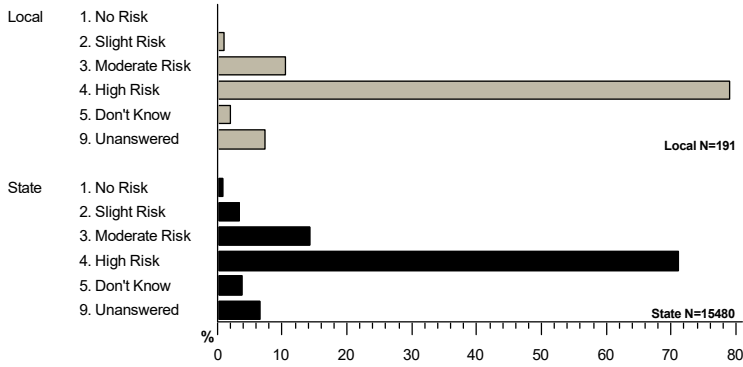

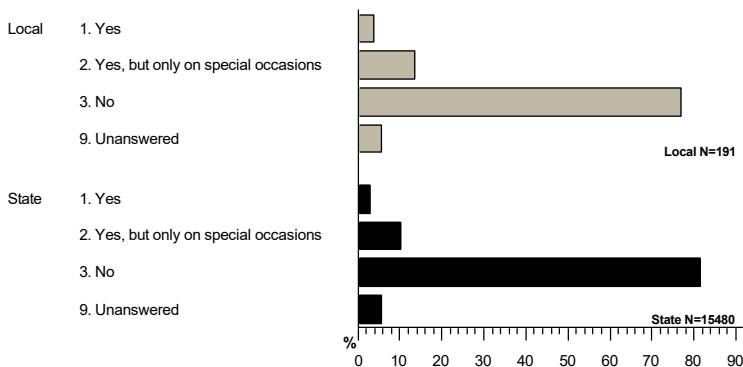

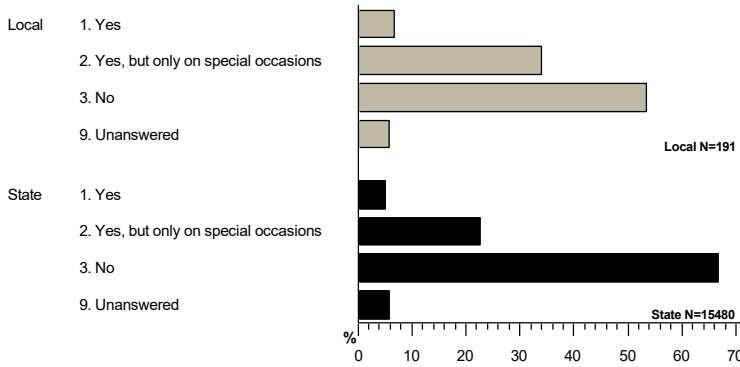

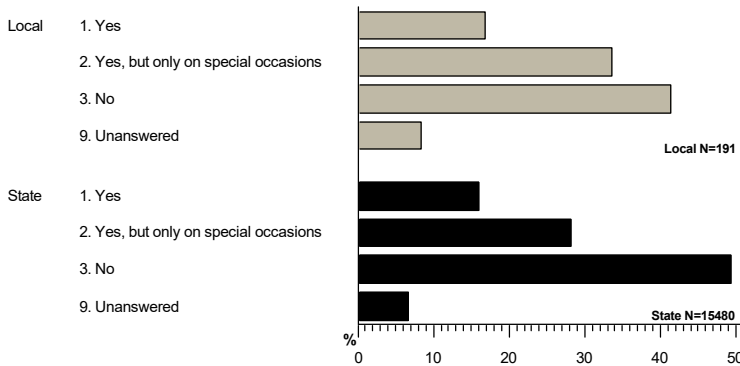

**7. Do you think it is OK for parents to offer their youth alcoholic beverages in their home?**



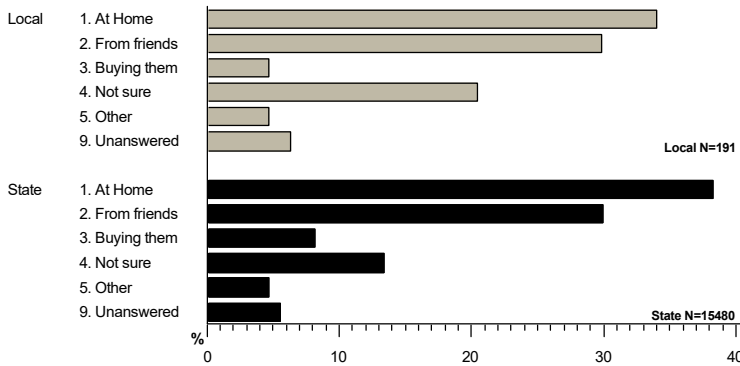

**8. Do you think most adults in our community feel it is OK for parents to offer their youth alcoholic beverages in their home?**



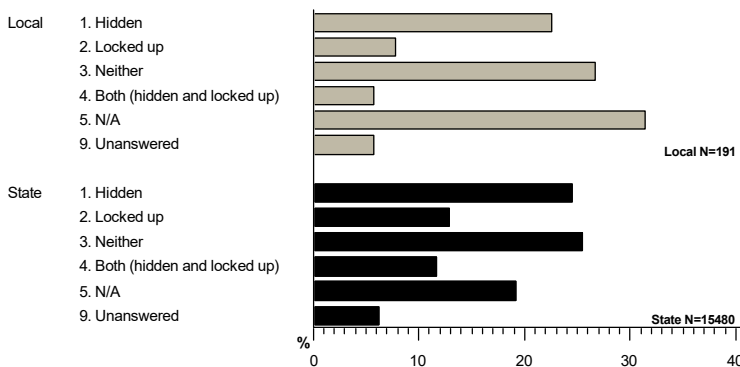

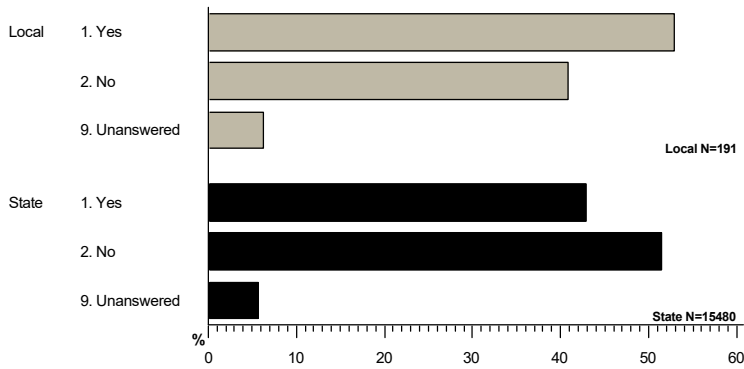

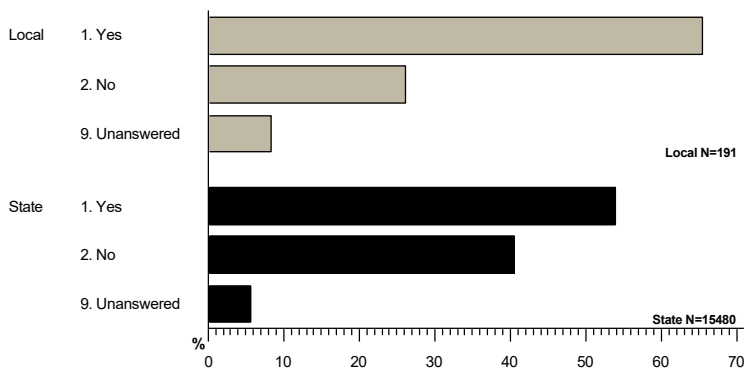

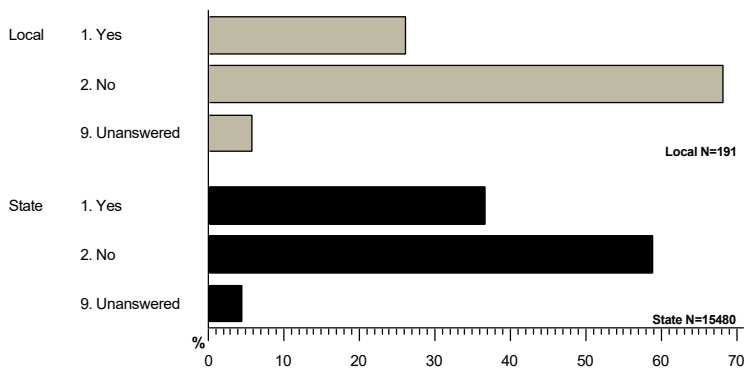

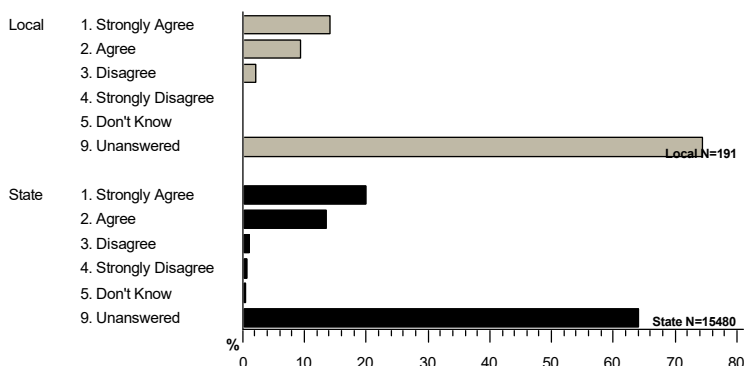

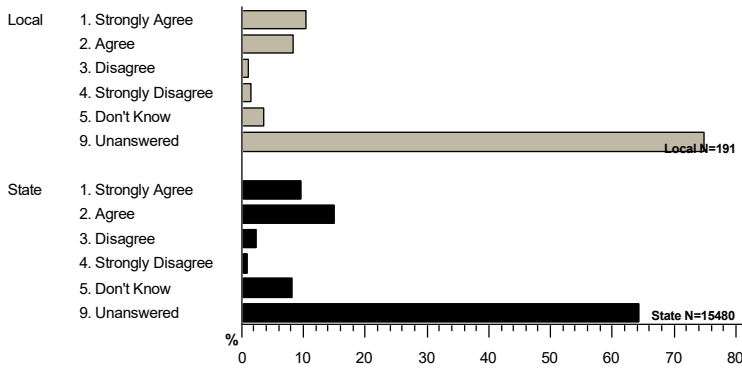

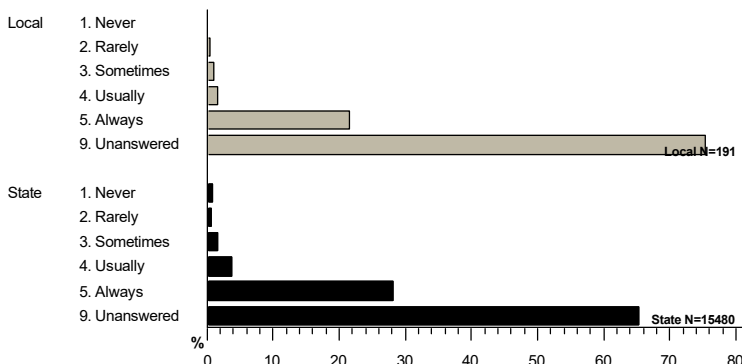

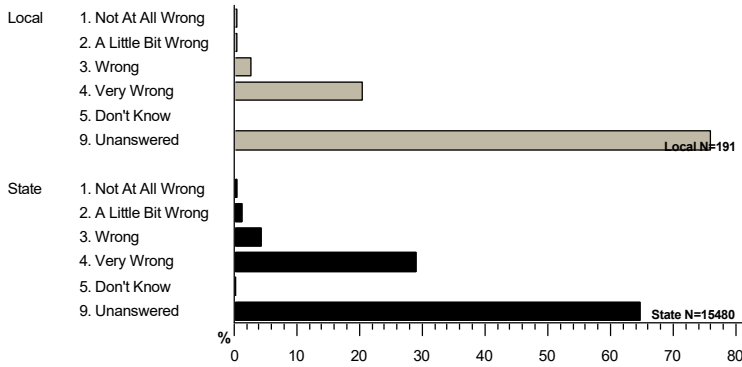

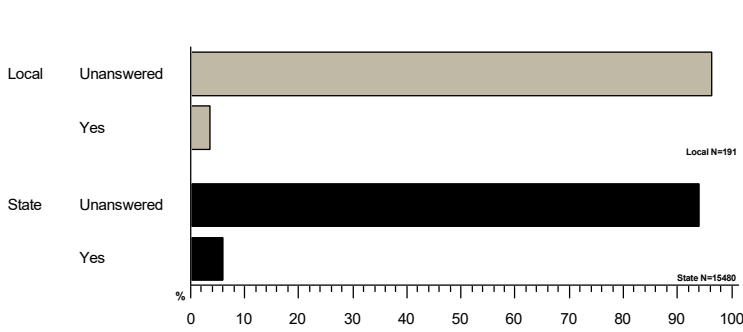

**22b. What is your race? Black or African American**



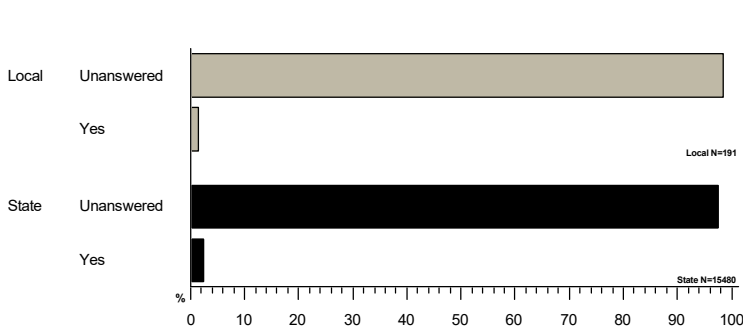

**23a. What languages are spoken in your home? Cambodian**



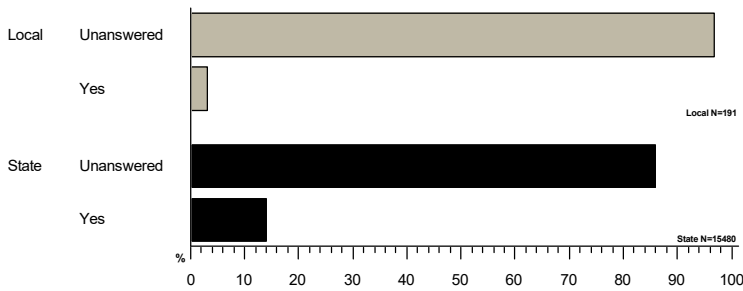
