

Center Road Overlay - Phase 5

In August 2017, Jefferson County Public Works successfully completed overlaying 2.26 miles of Center Road with hot mix asphalt from milepost 0.0 to 2.26. The project included one culvert replacement and full depth repairs at locations with significant pavement deterioration. The repairs and asphalt overlay rehabilitated and extended the service life of the existing pavement by eliminating surface distresses that can lead to pavement failure over time. The overlay also reduced pavement roughness and irregularities resulting in a better ride for drivers.

Lakeside Industries of Port Angeles, WA constructed the project for \$698,812. The project was 90 percent grant funded by the County Roads Administration Board Rural Arterial Program and 10 percent funded by the Public Infrastructure Fund.

Center Road is a critical major collector road that transports residents, visitors and goods throughout Jefferson County. The 15.01-mile-long road connects the communities of Chimacum and Quilcene and provides access to State Routes 19, 101, and 104. The wide paved shoulders make the road a favorite route for bicyclists.
